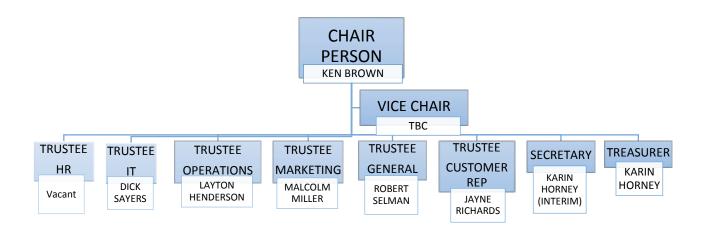
## Our Board of Trustees:
